### Did you know that Silver and Gold prices change every day?

\*Today the price of silver is £1.00 per gram  
gold is £35.00 per gram

Let's compare this:

A bag of Caster Sugar from Tesco's costs £1.50 for 500grams.

At today's price:

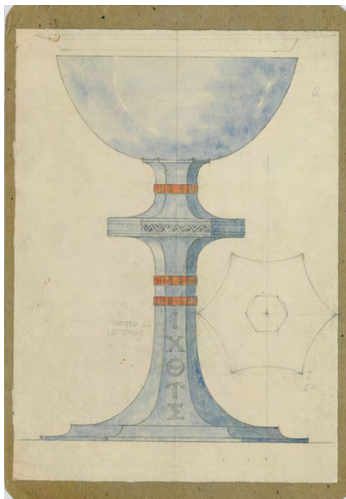
500g of Silver costs - £500.00

500g of Gold costs - £17,500.00

This means that if you want to design something that is symmetrical in silver or gold it is important to be accurate.
